1. Payment of \$100.00 for the Indoor Facility Fee and Insurance by cash or credit card. This will be required in full the first day of indoor practice.
2. OVFL Insurance form filled out and signed this will be required the first day of indoor practice.
3. A information Package (pg. 1-3) & Acknowledgement Form
4. A Medical Release Form
5. An OVFL Registration Form (AVAILABLE FROM COACHES)
6. A Two pieces of I.D. clearly copied **twice** – Any two of Ontario Health Card, Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate, Driver's License, valid Passport, landed Immigrant Certificate
7. A Bulldog Player Profile Form
8. A Release Form for using your photo on the web site
9. Payment of \$520.00 for Varsity, Junior Varsity & Bantam, Payment of \$440.00 for Peewee & Atom by cash or credit card (Mastercard & Visa) due in full May 1/2010
10. A \$250.00 Equipment deposit, either by a credit card HOLD or cash **no cheques**, due the day you pick up your equipment. **NO equipment will be issued without payment**
11. The Rep Package if required will be \$60 which will include 1 game shirt and game bag
12. Acknowledgement Form

### REFUND POLICY

It is the desire of the Brampton Minor Football to be as fair as possible to those players leaving our program before the end of the season. This desire to be fair is of course balanced against the financial and commitment needs of the club. With this in mind, the Bulldogs have instituted the following policy regarding refunds:

For all players leaving the team for any reason, anytime between their respective sign up date and April 15 2010, the club will refund their \$520.00 registration fee for Varsity, Junior Varsity & Bantam or Peewee & Atom \$440.00 registration fee less a \$100.00 administration fee (the indoor facility fee and insurance fee is non refundable in any circumstance). This will cover the team's costs associated with registering the player in the Ontario Varsity Football League & Ontario Minor Football League. For all players leaving the team for any reason, anytime after the April 15, 2010 no monies will be refunded. If a player has attended practices past the first regular season game, he has in essence participated in more than two weeks of a skills camp and no refund will be proffered.

### EQUIPMENT POLICY

All equipment issued to players by Brampton Minor Football remains the property of the club and must be returned upon demand. All players will sign for the equipment issued and have the appropriate equipment deposit as described above. You will be issued a receipt upon return of it. All players are responsible for their own equipment. Brampton Minor Football is not responsible for any lost, misplaced or stolen articles.

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## Medical Release Form

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## Player Expectations

### Indoor Practices:

- Indoor practice starts at 7pm for Bantams & 9pm for Varsity & JV sharp
- Doors will be locked at 15 mins after start of practice
- Any player coming after 15 mins **will not be permitted to practice.**
- Any player not fully dressed and practice ready by start of practice will be classified as **missing practice**
- Any players not practicing **will not be allowed on the practice field.**

### Outdoor Practices:

- Outdoor practices start at 6:30pm sharp
- Any player not fully dressed and on the field by 7:15pm **will be classified as having missed practice and cannot stand on the side lines.**
- Each player will have two grace practices – this allows players to get into practice without an absence being counted against them. Once the two grace practices have been used it will revert to being missed practices.
  - **1 missed practice in a game week – player will sit out one quarter of the game**
  - **2 missed practices in a game week – player will sit out game**
  - **If a player doesn't attend practice(s) because they are missing a game their suspension will continue to the next game.**
- Excusable reasons, with prior notice, for missing Practices – **Exams, Proms, Athletic Banquets, Graduations.** Coaches or Team Managers must be informed before practice if a player is going to miss a practice and the reason for the absences.

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## Equipment Responsibilities:

- Players are responsible to have proper practice equipment/attire and failure to do so will result in player being removed from practice. Proper attire does not include shorts over practice pants or head gear under helmets.
- An injured player must wear a practice shirt or jersey and have their helmet with them at practice. Failure to do so will result in an absence at practice.

## Paperwork Responsibilities:

- The player has the responsibility to follow the administrative dates. The player must have all of their data completed by the dates given. This includes payments, information forms, birth certificates or any other information that is required or they will not be allowed to practice.

## On Field Conduct:

- Win, Loose or Tie the players must act with respect towards their opponents, teammates, officials and the game of football.
- **Absolutely NO** insubordination or attitude on or off the fields will be tolerated
- Conduct detrimental to the team, coaches or players will face possible suspensions under the coach's discretion from one game to a full expulsion from BMFA. Any suspensions will have to be brought to the operations committee by the Head Coach.

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## CITIZENSHIP POLICY

It will be the practice of Brampton Minor Football to ensure that all players, coaches, officials and spectators are treated in a respectful and thoughtful manner. Certain types of behaviours and actions are unacceptable and offensive to many people. With this in mind the club will institute the following policy:

- Each player will respect the property and personal rights of teammates, coaches, opponents, spectators and reporters. The use of profanity, taunting, "trash talking" and any other action that denigrates opponents, officials, teammates, coaches, spectators and reporters will not be tolerated.
- Any such actions will result in sanctions taken against the player. Severe infractions or continual disregard of this policy by a player could lead to suspension or dismissal from the team.
- Any Bulldog player involved in incidents that result in the team being fined by the League will be responsible for the payment of that fine. The player will remain on suspension until the fine is paid.

**As part of our registration process, a player must sign and have his parent or guardian sign the Acknowledgment Form before he is officially registered and allowed to practice or play for the Bulldogs.**

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## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I hereby acknowledge that I have read Brampton Minor Football policies on refunds, practice commitments, equipment, and citizenship.
